



2019 NATIONAL TRAIL RACEWAY JEGS WEDNESDAY NIGHT
RULES AND REGULATIONS
(Revision 3-11-19)



SCHEDULE:

- Gates open 4:30 pm
- Tech Starts 4:45 pm
- Time Trials 5 pm
- Eliminations 7:30 pm

ENTRY:

- \$20 Entry fee per class

REGULAR CLASSES:

- 1. Big Dawg (7.50 to 13.99)**
 - a) Electronics permitted.
 - b) No motorcycles.
 - c) Any tire allowed.
 - d) Super Pro or Pro Rules apply.
- 2. Truck (10.00 & slower)**
 - a) Box racers will race each other until there is only 1 and then will be merged with slicks.
 - b) Only Pickups, El Caminos, etc.
 - c) Street Tires and Slicks will be separated until 8 trucks or less.
 - d) Pro or Sportsman Rules apply.
- 3. Motorcycle (7.50 & slower)**
 - a) Electronics permitted.
 - b) Open to all motorcycles.
 - c) Super Pro Bike and Street Motorcycle Rules apply.
- 4. Street (10.00 & slower)**
 - a) No Electronics.
 - b) Must have DOT Approved Tires.
 - c) Pro or Sportsman Rules apply.
- 5. Sport Compact (7.50 & slower)**
 - a) No Delay Boxes or Throttle Stops allowed.
 - b) Open to Imports and Domestic cars considered "sport compact".
 - c) No V8 or larger engines.
 - d) Pro or Sportsman Rules apply.
- 6. High School (12.00 & slower)**
 - a) Open to all racers currently attending high school at the beginning of the season.
 - b) No Electronics.



- c) Must have DOT Approved Tires.
- d) Sportsman Rules apply.

SPECIALTY CLASSES:

- 1. Modern Muscle (10.00 & slower) May 15, June 19, July 10, August 21, September 4**
 - a) Open to all 2004 or newer Modern Muscle Cars (ie. Camaro, Mustang, GTO, Challenger, Charger, Corvette, etc.).
 - b) No Delay Boxes or Throttle Stops.
 - c) Pro or Sportsman Rules apply.
- 2. Speed Angels (9.50 & slower) May 22, June 12, July 25, August 28, September 25**
 - a) Only women may compete in this class.
 - b) Open to all years, makes and models of cars. (No motorcycles, dragsters, roadsters or altered).
 - c) Pro or Sportsman Rules apply.
- 3. Nostalgia (10.00 & slower) May 29, June 26, July 31, August 21, September 4**
 - a) Only vehicles 1979 and Older (no dragsters, roadsters, altered or motorcycles).
 - b) No Delay Boxes or Throttle Stops.
 - c) Pro or Sportsman Rules apply.
- 4. Open Comp (9.00 & slower) May 8, June 5, July 17, August 28, September 25**
 - a) No Delay Boxes or Throttle Stops.
 - b) .500 Pro Tree.
 - c) Dial-in/Index based on racer's quickest time-trial run. The dial-in will be 1/10th faster than their quickest run in time-trials (ie. a racer runs 10.10, 10.15, 10.19 in time trials, the racer will be assigned the dial of 10.00 for the rest of the night.)
 - d) Runs of 9.00 and quicker will not count and the run will go down as 28.00.
 - e) Pro or Sportsman Rules apply.
- 5. Super Shifters (9.00 & slower) May 22, June 12, July 25, August 28, September 25**
 - a) No Delay Boxes or Throttle Stops.
 - b) No Motorcycles.
 - c) Operation of the clutch shall be a direct action of the driver's foot.
 - d) Approved dampening system will be allowed for non-soft lock clutches and clutchless transmissions.
 - e) All gear changes must be a result from direct action from the driver.
 - f) No Pneumatic and/or Hydraulic Shifters.
 - g) No Throttle Timers or Electric Shifters.
 - h) Pro or Sportsman Rules Apply.

DISTANCE:

- All classes will be contested at 1/4 mile unless deemed necessary by Race Director to change to 1/8 mile.

TIME TRIALS:

- Only one run per session.
- Street Tires Lanes 1 & 2.
- Slicks Lanes 3 & 4.



- Motorcycle Lane 5.
- Open Comp Lanes 1 & 2.

ELIMINATIONS:

- Random Pairing until 8 or less vehicles.
- First round singles will be randomly selected.
- Singles for all other unladdered rounds will be decided by best winning reaction time from the previous round winners.
- Ladders will be based on best reaction times from the previous round winners.
- Sportsman Ladders will be used.
- Modern Muscle, Speed Angels, Super Shifters, Nostalgia, Open Comp will be on a ladder 2nd round no matter the car count.

POINTS REGISTRATION:

- Racers must fill out an official registration form and submit it to National Trail Raceway, in order to enter the points series.
- The fee is \$5 per class.

POINTS:

- There will be 12 events scheduled for this season and racers will score their best 9 events.
- If an event is rained out and no points are awarded racers will only score their best 8 out of 11, 7 out of 10 events, 6 out of 9 events.
- If in 9 events or less points are awarded, 6 events will be scored.
- Modern Muscle, Speed Angels, Open Comp, Super Shifters, Nostalgia have 5 events scheduled for this season and will score all 5 events towards their points championship.

PAYOUT POOL

- For racers in Big Dawg and Open Comp have the option to enter the payout pool. It is \$20 cash to enter and the split will 80/20. The racer that goes the furthest in eliminations will get the 80% and the racer that goes the 2nd furthest in eliminations will get 20%. In the event of tie the payout will be split among those racers tied.

PAYOUTS:

- All JEGS Wednesday Night Classes are Plaque only.

TOP GUN

- The 2019 National Trail Raceway JEGS Wednesday Night Top Gun will be contested between the Champions of Big Dawg, Truck, Sport Compact, High School, Street, and Motorcycle.
- All champions will make a single pass attempting to score the best package.
- The racer with the best package (Reaction time + amount over dial in) will be the winner. Red lights and going under the dial-in are disqualifications.
- The Top Gun Champion will receive a \$150 JEGS Gift Card and 2019 JEGS Wednesday Night Top Gun Champion Jacket.



YEAR-END AWARDS:

- National Trail Raceway will honor the top 2 in the points at the Year-End Banquet.

DECALS:

- All JEGS Wednesday Night Series racer must display a JEGS decal on both sides of their vehicle during time trials and eliminations. Any driver not displaying the decals will forfeit any points earned that day.

ALL RULES, INTERPRETATIONS OF THE RULES, QUESTIONS AND PROTESTS ARE LEFT UP TO THE FINAL DISCRETION OF THE RACE DIRECTOR. IF THE SITUATION WARRANTS ACTION IN ANY EVENT, THE RACE DIRECTOR HAS THE FINAL WORD.
